



IMPACT TO THE CHURCHILL AREA

Larkspur Elementary School Classroom addition:

2-story classroom addition of 23 classrooms and teacher support areas.



Churchill High School Athletic Facility replacement:

Construction of a new athletic facility on the existing soccer field area. This will include competition gym (600 seats) and auxiliary gym (150 seats). Also athletic and PE locker/dressing/shower rooms areas, varsity team sports cages, training room, weight room, wrestling/multi-purpose room, coaches office area, lobby, concession stand and public restrooms, associated civil and drainage work; construct new soccer field adjacent to the baseball field, construct four new tennis courts, and removal of the existing athletic/PE facilities and replacement with new parking areas.

Eisenhower Middle School auditorium renovation:

Includes seating and floor replacement, interior painting, wall and window treatments, stage lighting and sound system upgrades.

Eisenhower Middle School campus-wide restroom renovations:

Includes flooring, fixture, lighting, toilet partition replacements and wall refinishing for all restroom areas.

District-wide sports facility:

Will include a combined football/soccer stadium with seating capacity for 10,000; will include an 8-lane track, parking for 2,500 and related infrastructure. Proposed bond also includes design costs for a baseball stadium.

All elementary, middle and high schools will receive:

- HVAC systems in their gyms (air-conditioning).
- Instructional technology (such as classroom computers, teacher laptops, distance learning equipment, projectors, graphing calculators) and related technology infrastructure (security cameras for all elementary and middle schools, additional security cameras at all high schools, networking upgrades and software).

Coker, Harmony Hills and Larkspur elementary schools will have their metal gyms replaced with masonry gyms to facilitate the air-conditioning mentioned above.
